The Game Changer program is for immigrant young adults looking for skills training and job search support. It is designed to:

- Improve your skills and abilities to make you successful in the workplace.
- Connect your talents to job opportunities that have meaning.
- Build a supportive community where participants help and encourage each other.
- Help you identify and deal with behavioural obstacles that might limit your employment and engagement in your community.



My daughter has had a couple jobs but always quit after the first few shifts.


The RiseUP counsellor helped my daughter by job coaching and it greatly reduced her anxiety.

- Online entrepreneurial skills training

Online, blended learning takes place in Phases 1 & 2. Coaching occurs throughout the entire program duration.



- Phase I: Concept Creation (8 weeks)
- Phase 2: Business Plan Writing (12 weeks)
- Phase 3: Launch & Implementation Support (16-32 weeks)
